VI New Business

1. Deer Population Chairman Mlachak received a memo (see attachments) from Councilperson Koski regarding the Environmental Committee meeting on January 20, 2009. Upon review, Ms. Dakes and Ms. Bevis stated that all this information was discussed last May. All members agreed that the May 22 meeting at the Community Center presented by Scott Peters of the Division of Wildlife provided us with the same information and more. Chairman Mlachak suggested a survey in the Connection to get feedback from the Wickliffe community. The deadline for the April 1 edition should be March 10. Members compiled a short list of questions for the survey. Ms. Barnes suggested it be a mail-in survey. Chairman Mlachak also cited information on deer strikes in Wickliffe that he obtained from our Police Department. In 2007, there were nine collisions; in 2008, there were thirteen collisions, both years resulting in mostly minor vehicular damage and no injuries. Most collisions were on I-90 or at E300th and Ridge Road with only one strike occurring on SR2.
